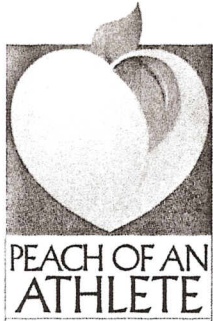


## Atlanta Area Council, Boy Scouts of America 2010 Special Events

**Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at the Cobb Energy Center**

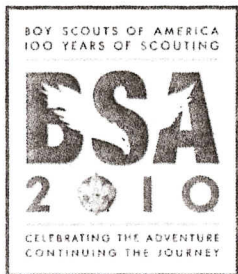
