Every vehicle will also need a Georgia State Park pass: \$5.00 if purchased at the park or visit a Cobb County library to check out one with a library card for FREE. If you plan to fish, adults must have a fishing license. **Payment due by February 27.**

Schedule

Friday, March 12

Friday campers can set up camp and have supper on your own.

Saturday, March 13

Saturday arrivers set up camp. Breakfast and lunch on your own.

8:00 - 8:30 am We will need volunteers to help prepare breakfast

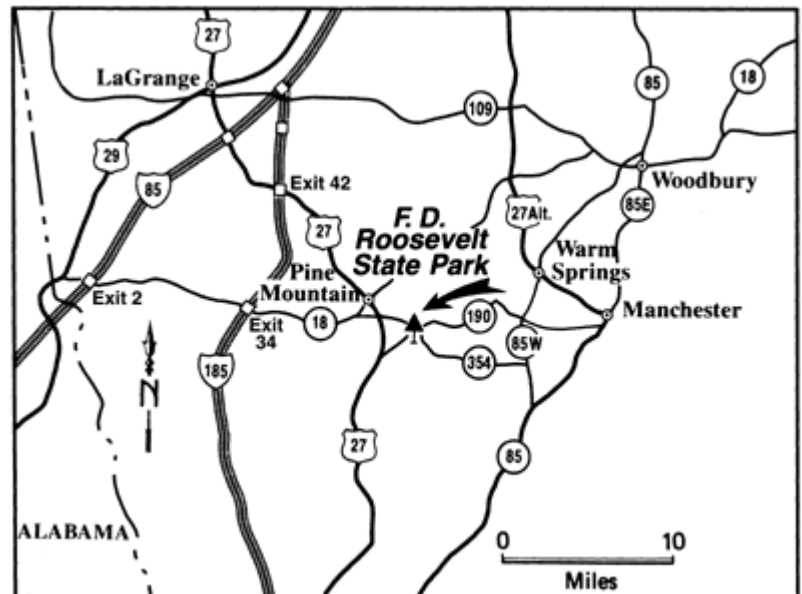
8:30 - 9:30 am Breakfast

F.D. Roosevelt State Park

Pine Mountain, GA 31822

Located just off I-185 near Callaway Gardens, west of Warm Springs on Ga. Route 190, or south of Pine Mountain off U.S. Hwy. 27.

We will be staying in the park's Pioneer Campground: Primitive, rugged site for groups only. 10 person minimum. Site is located by itself. Site has water but no electricity. Site has pit toilets, picnic tables and small shelter. Group must check in at park office before setting up camp. Open area for tent camping only. What to bring: tent, ground cover, sleeping mats, sleeping bags, clothes, food and cooking supplies for all meals except Saturday supper and Sunday breakfast, flashlights, water bottles, personal hygiene items.

Optional: fishing supplies, Cub Scout Handbook, ponchos.

If you are interested in reserving a cottage, most are about \$100 per night. You can reserve them on the GA State Parks website (<http://www.gastateparks.org/FDR>). **A parent must accompany each child. If you reserve a cabin, your child must remain with you.**

There are other activities that are available near FDR State Park if you are interested in going somewhere on Sunday. Wild Animal Safari is \$17.95 per adult and \$14.95 per child. Callaway Gardens is \$18.00 per adult and \$9.00 per child. If there is enough interest, we can probably get reduced group pricing.
