

**CUB SCOUT FALL CAMPOUT AT JOHN TANNER STATE PARK

Tentative Cost: \$5.00 per family plus \$2.00 per person includes campsite, hot dog supper and s'mores. Every vehicle will need a Georgia State Park pass: \$5.00 if purchased at the park or visit a Cobb County library to check out one with a library card for FREE. If you plan to fish, adults must have a fishing license.

10:00 pm - 7:00 am Quiet Hours

1:00 pm Check-out time (campsite must be cleared out, but you may stay in the park as long as you like)

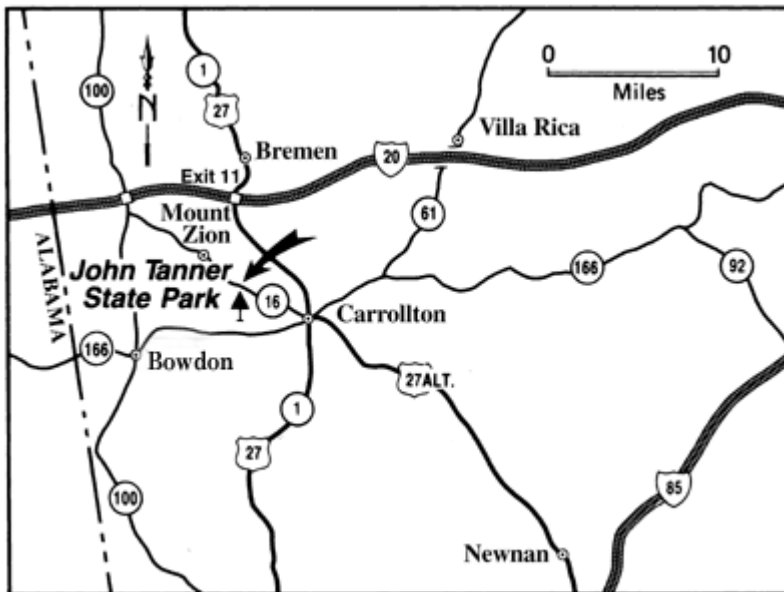

ACTIVITIES:

- Swimming
- Pedal Boat and Fishing Boat Rental (seasonal) (pedal boats are \$3 per person per half hour)
- Boating - private boats permitted, electric motors only
- Hiking - 3/4-mile nature trail and 1-mile lake loop trail
- Miniature Golf (\$3)

We will be staying in the park's Pioneer Campground. This is a primitive, rugged site for groups only with a minimum of 10 people. Site is located by itself. Site does not have water, electric, or restrooms (must use campground facilities). No vehicles allowed at site, must park in main lot. All groups must have adult supervision.
